





Presentation Station

Designed and built in New Zealand, this presentation/teleconference trolley allows quick setup on a stable platform using large diameter castors for easy lift and inter-room movement. The unit has a top mounted camera shelf and incorporates an equipment shelf with an additional lift out laptop shelf for local presentations. Integrated trolley handles allow simple movement in confined spaces and the bifurcated vertical extrusion frame allows convenient cable management and storage.

Suitable for 32 to 50" landscape mounted displays. An intrigal locking clamp secures the screen to the stand, substantially increasing security.



Dual Handed USB Trackball Keyboard

A version of the fully ergonomic E-Type MALTRON keyboard with an integrated trackball in the central palm rest.

In the position the ball may be easily moved by the thumb with the fingers cupped and the hand resting over the key thumb group. The top of the ball is slightly below the palm rest surface so that it does not interfere with normal keyboard use.

The central location of the trackball enables either thumb to be used with the wrist kept straight and the hand tilted outwards in the comfortable position.



Single Handed Keyboard

MALTRON single handed keyboards have been developed as a logical step forward to meet the needs of those who must perform keyboard operations with one hand.

The shape matches natural hand movement and the key arrangement minimizes finger movement, raising speed and relieving frustration.

Word-processing input speeds of 85 words per minute have been demonstrated.

The fully ergonomic shape ensures freedom from strain and no RSI type problems have been reported in over 10 years, although all the work is done by one hand.

Both Left and Right hand models are designed for "Touch Typing".

Self paced training manuals ensure quick, easy learning. Both screen and paper based versions are available.

Mouth Head Stick Keyboard

Push-On, Push-Off keys are provided for Shift, Control and Alt. MALTRON keyboards all have the ability to turn off key repeating at the keyboard if it is not wanted. If allowed by the software in use, the repeat rate can be set to SLOW, MEDIUM or FAST at the keyboard.

The shape matches natural head movement and the key arrangement minimises finger or stick activity, raising speed and relieving frustration.

An optional articulated arm holds the keyboard in almost any position to suit the head or mouth stick use.



Expanded Keyboard with Integral Key-guard

The MALTRON EXPANDED keyboard has been robustly designed with a strong steel construction to withstand heavy use, and a nylon coating for a smooth wipe-clean surface. It provides enhanced access for physically disabled and visually impaired users.

Extra SPACE keys for easier access, sticky shift keys - these keys remain active until another key is pressed, eliminating the need to use two hands. Indicator LEDS's - All Control, Alt Shift and Lock keys have lights to inform the user of status.

A Shift Lock key - this key is provided to allow the shift function to be locked on, variable repeat rate - allows the repeat rate to be turned off, or set at one of three speeds via the keyboard, subject to the software.

Extra keyboard socket - allows a standard keyboard to be connected to the expanded keyboard, and then used alongside simply by toggling a switch.




